“Army of the Blue” that marched south to put down rebellion.

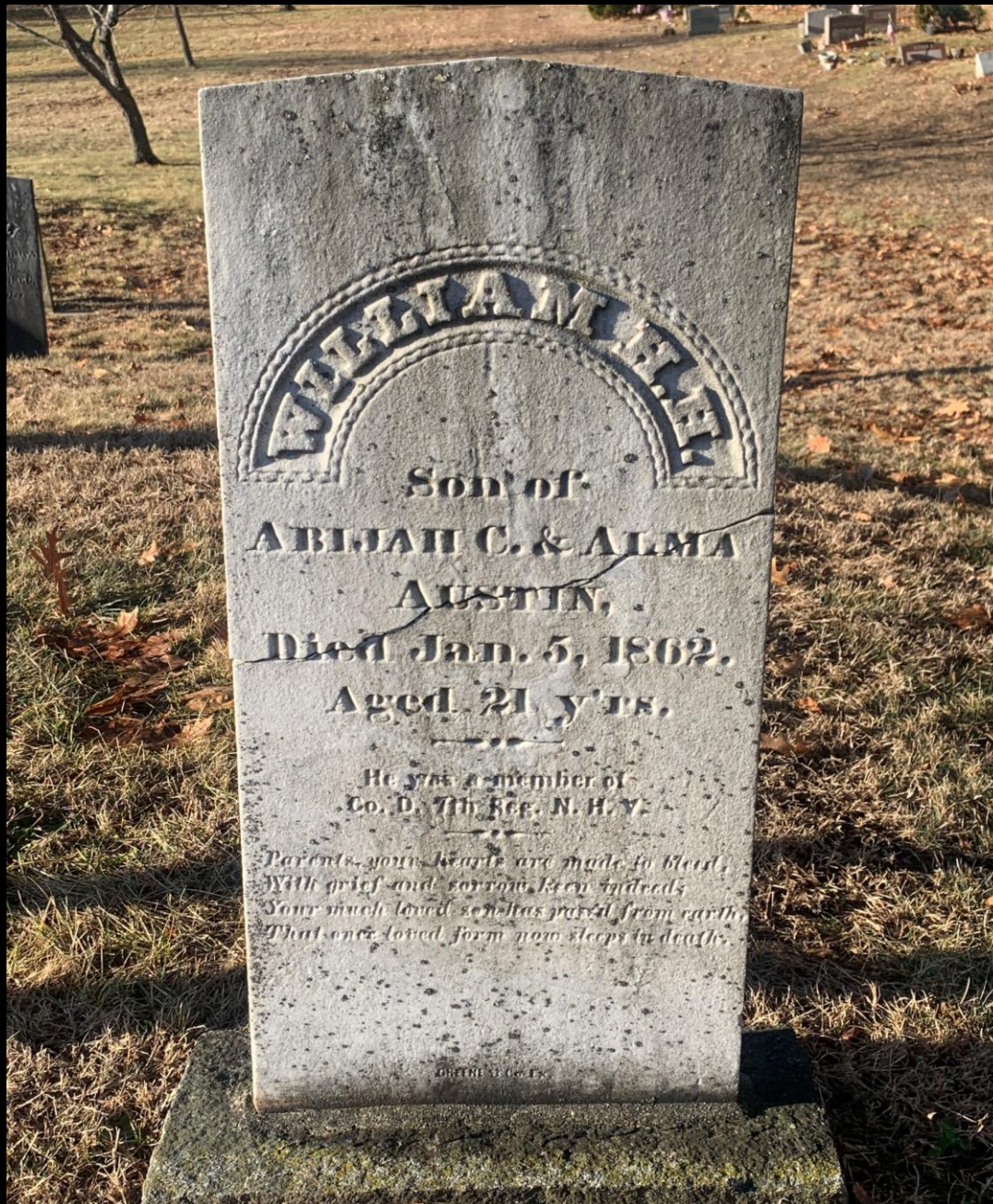
