Kensington Public Library Trustee Meeting Minutes

Present: Susie Gilbert, Heather Ritter, Lauri Murphy, and Susan Bascom

Meeting was called to order at 4:33 pm at Kensington Public Library (KPL)

Previous meeting minutes: Jul 14, 2022 meeting minutes were unanimously approved

Statistics for July and August:

- Total library visits for Jul (650) and Aug (738) showed a steady increase in monthly visits in 2022
- Total circulation showed an increase in Jul (1360) and decreased slightly in Aug (1015)

Budget:

- While overall 2022 expenses have not exceeded allocated budget (70.8% spent Jan-Aug), increased cost in specific areas (e.g. heat, electricity, programming) have shown that the allocated 2022 budget will not be adequate for the coming year
- 2023 proposed budget reviewed and finalized for submission to Select Board.
 - o Two water filters need replacement due to high levels of arsenic, and to make the library's water safe to drink. Unanimous decision to present a warrant article to raise the needed funds (\$5000)
